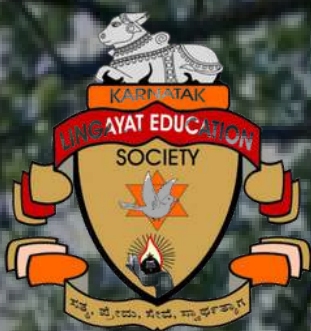

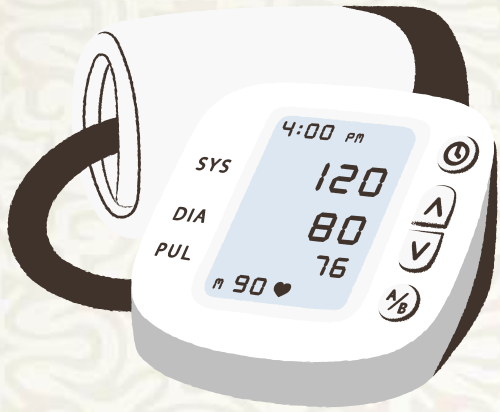

Tuberculosis AWARENESS PROGRAM

Students had the wonderful privilege of learning about the dangers of the common yet hazardous bacteria—Tuberculosis.

Tuberculosis (TB) is an extremely contagious, airborne infection primarily caused by the bacterium *Mycobacterium tuberculosis*, usually affecting the lungs and also other parts of the body. It spreads when an infected person coughs or sneezes, releasing droplets into the air. Numerous symptoms include chronic cough, fever, and weight loss. The cure for this hazardous infection is a very time consuming method which is the reason why it is best to take preventative measures before the infection strikes.

Dengue AWARENESS PROGRAM

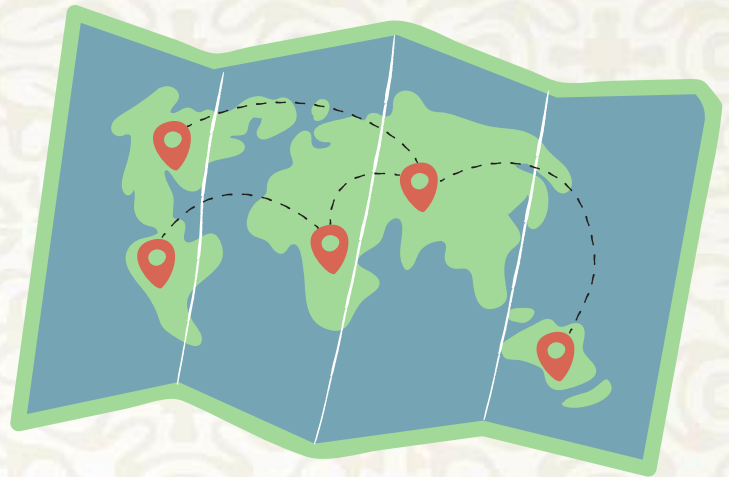

Dengue, a mosquito-borne viral infection caused by the dengue virus (DENV), transmitted primarily by *Aedes Aegypti*. The mosquito causes a severe flu-like illness, including high fever, headache, joint pain, and rashes. While most recover in a week, severe dengue can lead to bleeding, organ failure, and death.

To raise awareness about the deadly disease dengue, the Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara Palike (BBMP), in collaboration with ESI doctors, conducted an informative awareness program for students of Grades 8–10. The session provided valuable insights into the causes, symptoms, prevention, and control of dengue, while educating students on effective measures to eliminate mosquito breeding and protect themselves from the disease.

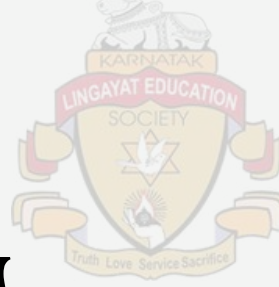
VISIT TO AN ORPHANAGE

Our students of Grade 9 visited two different old age homes. It made them more empathetic and helped them to advance their moral compass.

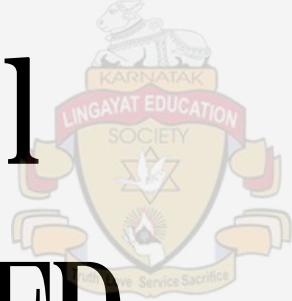
They took goodies like tea, sugar, grains, and more to help the inhabitants of the old age home.

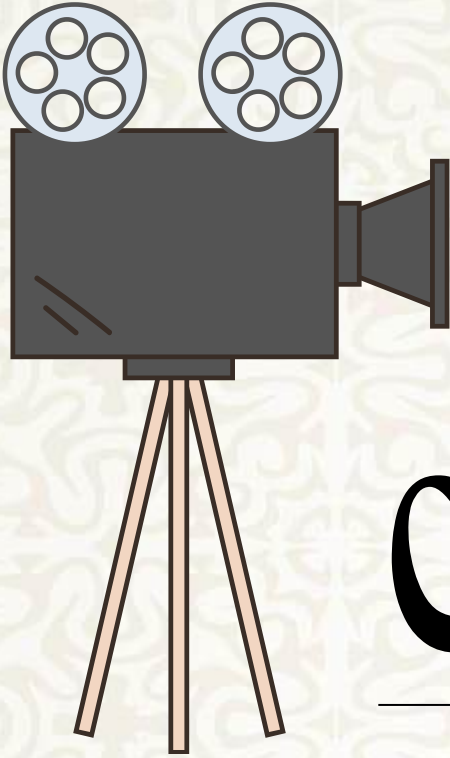
On account of the National Space Day, a competition was conducted by the Visveswaraya Industrial and Technological Museum in Bangalore.

Save the Environment Activity

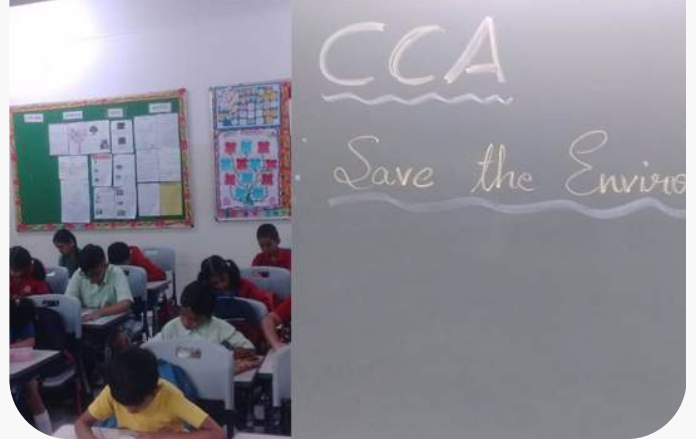
